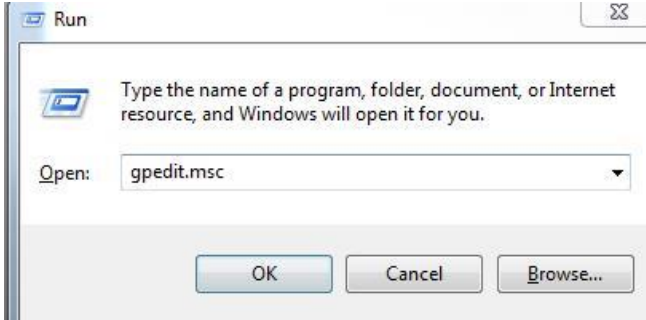


Turn off IE Security Policy
